## Los Angeles Wheelmen VP Report - June 22, 2021

## Hello All:

Last Week: Last Saturday was the last of our Grand Tour training rides. As usual, Greg Analian and I rode although I never saw Greg. I believe Greg and I were the only riders to do all 12 trainers, although in my case I did not complete 3 of them. However, this week I was joined by Mario Biagioli, our newest member. Things were going well, but then near the top of Hawthorne Blvd in Palos Verdes, Mario hit a bump in the street and went down. Fortunately there was a policeman on the spot who immediately called paramedics and two other passing doctors stopped to give assistance. Although he was initially knocked out, he came to and was fairly lucid by the time the paramedics arrived. He later e-mailed me that although he had a number of minor injuries, there was nothing serious. I hope he is recovering well and that he won't let this inauspicious first ride with the club deter him from riding with us again.

It turned out that hitting the same bump that took Mario down had caused my front tire to go flat. After fixing that, I considered calling it a day, but decided I should finish the trainer since it was the last one. I did finish, but near the end I realized my rear tire was slowly going down. I think the slow leak may have been caused by the same bump that took out my front tire. All in all, quite a bump. I didn't take any photos, but fortunately, Greg did. Most of the day was overcast and even foggy, so there weren't a lot of good photo opportunities.
