I wasn't aware that we had two so similar routes or I probably wouldn't have scheduled them so close together. Phil sent me this photo of the lunch stop most of their group went to.

This Week: On Sunday we will be riding from the "Corner" down to Manhattan Beach to watch some of the racing at the Manhattan Beach Grand Prix. This is an annual ride for us, but the Grand Prix was cancelled the last two years, so this is the first time we have done this in 3 years. The short is a simple ride down to the races and back. The medium adds a loop on down to Palos Verdes and to Golden Cove for lunch and then a return to the races. The long adds a loop completely around the peninsula including a climb over the switchbacks on the southeast side of the peninsula before returning to the races. The races take place all day, so no matter when you get there, you should be able to watch a little racing.

Warning: The Beach Cities Bicycle Club sent out a warning to it's members which Lora Chen and Nancy Domjanovich passed along to me.
